- Spend approximately 30 minutes on this section.

You read an interesting book during the school holidays.
Write a review of the book in which you relate aspects such as the plot, characterisation and themes. State why you would or would not recommend the book to other learners.

NOTE: Give the title of the book and the name of the author at the beginning of your review.
