
NOTE FOR THE LIFE SCIENCES TEACHER/INVIGILATOR

The Life Sciences teachers and invigilators must go through this information in the 45 minutes prior to the PAT.

The invigilator(s) will need to assess and record the following.

• Following instructions:

Five holes made as instructed; A, B, C and D written on paper in correct orientation (as per Figure A below), as well as E in the centre of the petri dish.



• Procedural skills:

Appropriate syringe used (10 ml)

• Manipulative skills:

Exactly 10 ml solution correctly drawn up in syringe.

The invigilator(s) must use the grids provided with the Instructions to Teachers and Laboratory Technicians to record the manipulation marks. The invigilator(s) must circle either the 0 or the 1 in EACH case and total the mark out of 3.

E.g.

When the candidates hand back the completed PATs at the end of the 90 minutes, the invigilator(s) MUST transfer these 3 marks onto the front cover of the script using a red pen.
