What are the NBTs?

The NBTs are a set of tests used to assess a student's academic literacy, general knowledge, and mathematical skill in an effort to measure academic readiness for university. The NBT is made up of 2 assessments. The first test is Academic & Quantitative Literacy and the second test is Mathematics.



Who needs to write the NBT?

- + Students applying to most South African universities and some colleges.
- + Different institutions and degree programs have varying requirements of the NBT and results to aim for.
- + All students who write the NBTs have to write the AQL test, whereas the MAT test is only for specific degrees.

How to book your test

- + Visit www.nbt.ac.za to book your test.
- + Various dates and venues across SA, find one that works for you.
- + Test bookings open on the first Monday in April 2019.
- + Depending on your location, tests will run almost every weekend from mid May 2019 to early January 2020.

How to prepare
